Recommended Evaluation Process and Timeline Flowchart

Beginning of New Evaluation Year Meeting July / September (Meeting to be conducted in executive session)

Topic 1: Leadership Team Goal / Priority Setting.

Topic 2: Superintendent's Professional Goals and Objectives.

Mid-Year Evaluation Meeting November / December (Meeting to be conducted in executive session)

Topic 1: Informal Leadership Team discussion regarding progress on goals and objectives.

Topic 2: Targeted informal feedback provided to Superintendent regarding his/her performance.

End of Year Evaluation Meeting April / May (Meeting to be conducted in executive session)

- Topic 1: Self-Assessment of individual members of the Leadership Team including discussion about goal attainment and handling of unanticipated challenges.
- Topic 2: Superintendent presents "year in review" self-assessment to Board of Education regarding his/her performance.

Board of Education Evaluation of the Superintendent May / June

(Meeting to be conducted in executive session)

Board of Education evaluates the Superintendent's job performance. A draft evaluation is developed during this meeting in districts where a written evaluation of the Superintendent is provided.

Meeting with Superintendent Regarding Draft Evaluation June

(Meeting to be conducted in executive session)

Meeting between the Board of Education as per Board of Education policy and the Superintendent to share and discuss the draft evaluation.

Formal Evaluation of the Superintendent June

Formal evaluation is completed and presented to the Superintendent of Schools by a representative(s) of the Board of Education as per policy.
