

Goals of LEAP Program

“The Why”

- To challenge students in innovative ways
- To increase capacity in students with oral presentations, community projects and STEM
- To create student agency (set of belief systems that demonstrate students are effective, cognitively able, and have voice and choice within their learning) within our schools

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Students will be engaged in accelerated activities in math and reading through literature, performance tasks, and 21st century skills needed for success in school and in the real world.

Tasks will challenge students to think critically and apply skills in new learning experiences. In collaboration with peers and certified teachers, students will be educated, challenged, and inspired in their academic achievements.



Criteria for LEAP

- 88th percentile or higher on the iReady Diagnostic (ELA)
- Level 4 on Smarter Balanced State Test (ELA or Math)
- This will all be project based learning. Depending on the project for the year we will look at ELA or Math scores more closely.
